Looking for a Red and White (wine) to pair with the Blue (skies) this weekend? Here are two new homegrown arrivals that are very limited in production and worth checking out.

### 2012 Sous Sol Syrah DuBrul Vineyard Yakima Valley (\$32)

“This is our second release from our Syrah lot in the acclaimed DuBrul Vineyard. We are excited to be working alongside Hugh and Kathy Shiels to emulate a true terroir-driven project. The Syrah is layered with a rustic bouquet of cooked dark fruit. It has ample notes of pepper, earthiness with an elegant, lingered finish that is made to complement savory cuisine. 37 cases made.” –Winemaker notes. This is an unheard price for wine made from DuBrul grapes. We suspect that the Shiels are interested in helping a young group of men and women succeed in their independent winery in Pioneer Square. We love this wine!

### 2014 Mark Ryan Winery Viognier Columbia Valley (\$28)

“The 2014 Viognier explodes from the glass with peach, apricot and jasmine with hints of orange peel and Meyer lemon. The palate presents a rich and luxurious attack with elements of honey, waxed fruit and melon. The wine finishes with ripe citrus and crushed rock notes.” –Winemaker notes.

“Aromas of Marionberry, black cherry, cocoa powder and sweet herbs. The drink leads with cherries and chocolate in a rich style, backed by good acidity, comfortable tannins and a return of sweet Marionberries. A blend of 92% Cabernet Sauvignon and 8% Merlot. Outstanding!”

### 2012 Cristom Mt. Jefferson Cuvée Pinot Noir Willamette Valley \$32.99/\$27.99/\$25.19

Consistency has made Cristom the #1 choice for restaurant Pinot Noirs in a 2014 Wine and Spirits national sommelier survey. “Made with a blend of grapes from each of the estate vineyards, and top quality fruit traded or purchased from neighboring vineyards, the Mt. Jefferson Cuvée conveys a rich diversity of place, deserving of its reputation as one of the most expansive yet stylistically consistent Pinot Noirs in the world.” –Winery notes. **New vintage.**

### 2013 Vietti Barbera d’Asti Tre Vigne Piedmont \$20.99/\$15.89/\$14.30

“Ruby purple color with ripe red cherry aromas with hints of mineral and vanilla. A dry, medium-bodied red wine with refreshing acidity (making it perfect to pair with food) and soft tannins, the Barbera d’Asti Tre Vigne is well balanced with good integration of oak, good complexity and a finish of more red cherries.”  
–Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

### 2013 Brigaldara Red Valpolicella Classico Veneto \$17.99/\$12.99/\$11.69

Offers a great deal for the money. This zesty and fresh blended red offers great fruit purity. The wine is juicy and lively with more cherry and wild berries on the close. A blend of 40% Corvina, 30% Corvinone, 20% Rondinella, 5%, Molinara and 5% Sangiovese. **New item.**

### 2014 Gosford Reserve Shiraz South Eastern Australia \$9.99/\$6.99/\$6.29

This 100% Shiraz is carefully selected from vineyards in South Eastern Australia by winemaker Ben Riggs. On the nose are ripe fruit aromas of currant and plum melded with spice and ash. Sweet varietal flavors of raspberry and plum on the palate with overtones of earth and spice leading to a lingering fruit finish. **New vintage.**

## White Wines

### 2014 Mark Ryan Winery Viognier Columbia Valley \$32.99/\$27.99/\$25.19

“The 2014 Viognier explodes from the glass with peach, apricot and jasmine with hints of orange peel and Meyer lemon. The palate presents a rich and luxurious attack with elements of honey, waxed fruit and melon. The wine finishes with ripe citrus and crushed rock notes.”  
–Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

### 2014 Savage Grace Grüner Veltliner Underwood Mountain Vineyards Columbia Gorge \$21.99/\$18.69/\$16.82

“Our first release of this Austrian varietal. The grapes were whole-cluster pressed and then fermented in a combination of neutral barrels and stainless steel, with 50% undergoing native fermentation to enhance complexity. This is a great food pairing wine, offering flavors of citrus fruit, honey and wet stone. Try it with shellfish and asparagus. 100 cases made.” –Winemaker note. **New item. Up and coming winemaker.**

### 2014 Cantine Pra Soave Classico Superiore \$21.99/\$15.99/\$14.39

The minerality, which is the distinctive characteristic of this cru, gives this wine great elegance. On the nose the aromas are of golden apples and peaches, as well as some mature exotic fruit and yellow citrus fruits. It is also lightly spiced with notes of lightly dried lavender and medicinal herbs. On the palate, it has good freshness. The fruit is mature and the wine has a long finish of sweet almond. **New item.**

### 2013 Feudi di San Gregorio Falanghina del Sannio Campania Italy \$18.99/\$15.89/\$14.30

“Soft, supple and well balanced, with floral aromas and flavors.” –Eric Asimov. - New York Times, 6/17/15. **New vintage.**

### 2014 Oyster Bay Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough New Zealand \$17.99/\$11.99/\$10.79

“Pale straw green in color with brilliant clarity, Oyster Bay Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is zesty and aromatic with lots of lively fruit characters. A concentration of assertive passionfruit and tropical fruit flavors with an abundant bouquet, it is a wine that is always crisp, elegant and refreshing.” –Winery notes. **New vintage.**



**2012 Uvaggio Vermentino Lodi California \$13.99/\$6.59/\$5.93**

A delicious, easygoing white wine with great freshness that keeps you coming back for another sip. Made from a hard-to-find variety in California, this bright wine is beautifully aromatic with lively yet subtle lime, quince and pear aromas. Flavors of melon and stone fruits with a mineral hint waiting for seafood. All free-run juice (no pressing), cool fermented without malolactic fermentation. **New vintage**

## Rosé Wines

**2014 Domaine Tempier Bandol Rosé \$42.99/\$37.39/\$33.65**

For rosé fanatics and fans of exceptional wines of all types, there may be no better pink tippie the world over than this Bandol Rosé from the star of the appellation, Domaine Tempier. "An intense fruit and floral nose make this an attractive rosé. The palate is rounded and full with fruity aromas of peach and pomegranate, followed by delicate spice notes and a pleasant freshness created by acidic balance."

—Winemaker notes. **New vintage. Limited.**

**2014 Domaine de la Fouquette Rosé Cuvée Rosée d'Aurore Côtes de Provence \$17.99/\$14.99/\$13.49**

"This wine is clear and exhibits a litchee color. Its nose is fruity and intense. It has a bright entry, shading toward pleasant, complex flavors of mandarin orange, and with red and black berries that develop in the mouth. Grenache/Cinsault/Syrah/Rolle. Organic."

—Winemaker notes. **New item.**

**2014 Cà Maiol 'Roseri' Valtenesi Charetto Italy \$17.99/\$13.39/\$12.05**

This Rosé is called 'Roseri' for the delicacy of its aroma that brings to mind the perfume of a rosebud. It is a blend of four grapes (Groppello, Marzemino, Sangiovese and Barbera). The bouquet recalls peach flowers, white currants, incense and litchis. The taste on the palate is soft and persistent. The finish features white peach and sage which is conferred by minerality. The particular structure thus obtained gives this wine greater longevity of some years, always maintaining intact the fragrance.

**2014 Planeta Rosé Sicily \$16.99/\$12.99/\$11.69**

"Pale pink with light fuchsia veining and tones similar to the interior of a strawberry. Wafts of red berried fruit like Ribera wild strawberries and pomegranate. In the background floral and tropical aromas. Fresh and mineral, flowing with a fine acidity. 50% Nero d'Avola, 50% Syrah."

—Winemaker notes. **New item.**

**2011 Michel Chapoutier Les Vignes de Bila-Haut Rosé Pays d'Oc Languedoc \$17.99/\$12.19/\$10.97**

"Each of the varieties in the blend offers up their unique flavors to combine a refreshing and crisp wine with 'high resolution' of flavors. The Cinsault gives the red fruits and gentle floral aromas. The Grenache supplies the crisp mineral flavors with a hint of citrus in the lingering finish." —Importer notes. **New vintage.**

**2014 Hecht & Bannier Rosé Côtes de Provence \$17.99/\$11.19/\$10.07**

"For the Côtes de Provence Rosé we take a path quite apart from the one used for our Languedoc Rosé, with its high proportion of Syrah. We seek a Provence rosé of immense charm and minerality redolent of dried herbs and mountain flowers. A blend of 45% Cinsault, 30 % Grenache and 25%, Syrah." —Winemaker notes. **New item.**

**2013 Château Rivière Rosé Castle River Minervois \$14.99/\$11.19/\$10.07**

"The vineyard is located on clay-limestone soils in the heart of the Minervois. The south orientated vineyard favors the good maturation of the grapes. The fermentation at low temperature of the Grenache and Syrah gives this Rosé a nose with intense aromas of raspberry and strawberry. The flavor is fleshy and greedy, revealing hints of red currants and cherries." —Winery notes. **New vintage,**

**2014 Domaine de la Brunely Rosé Ventoux \$12.99/\$9.39/\$8.45**

Brand new and fantastic. Grenache and Cinsault give this Rosé the classic flavors of the south of France. Soft, silky and delicious, this beautiful wine will make you very happy. But don't wait. Leschi Market grabbed five of the only 25 cases for the entire west coast! **New item.**
