New rosé is showing up nearly every day now, and will until June! Here are a couple of our new favorites!

2015 Vidal-Fleury Rosé Côtes du Rhône (\$14.99)

“Pale pink with salmon reflection. On the nose, delicate, based on a floral expression (peony) and fresh fruit (raspberry, strawberry). On the palate refreshing, fruity (raspberry). Mineral on the finish. A blend of 50% Cinsault, 30% Syrah and 20% Grenache.” -Winery notes.

2015 Gerard Bertrand Gris Blanc Rosé Pays d’Oc Languedoc Roussillon (\$13.99)

Pink in color plus grey and almost white tints. Grenache is the king of grape varieties when it comes to making light, racy, fruity rosés in contemporary style. Grenache reveals all its suppleness and cherry aromas. Its fig and sometimes cocoa flavors, coupled with rounded sensations on the palate, make Grenache one of the great varieties of the south of France.” –Winemaker notes.

Red Wines

2013 Mark Ryan Lonely Heart Cabernet Sauvignon Red Mountain \$102.99/\$88.99/\$80.09

“The star of the 2013’s is, without a doubt, this wine. A blend of 96% Cabernet Sauvignon, 3% Merlot and 1% Petit Verdot. Gorgeous on all counts, with full-bodied concentration, building tannin and lots of cassis, lead pencil shavings, violets and spring flower aromas and flavors, this thrilling wine will stand toe-to-toe with the greatest Cabernets coming out of Washington. As with all of this team’s wines, it has an elegance and seamlessness. Drink 2019 – 2038.”

2009 Côte Bonneville Carriage House Red Blend DuBrul Vineyard Yakima Valley \$59.99/\$46.99/\$42.29

“An arresting blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (62%), Merlot (27%) and Cabernet Franc, it displays purity with its herb, bay leaf, earth and cherry flavors. The exquisite balance is where this wine really shines, winning over on its elegance, detail and length rather than power. It shows first-class fruit and exceptional winemaking. Editors’ Choice.”

2011 Corsini Barolo Bussia Langhe \$47.99/\$37.39/\$33.65

“There should be an exhilarating rush of freshness on the nose, followed immediately by warming broader elements which can include candied cherries, bitter cherries, plums, strawberries and raspberries. There are also darker tones of chocolate, hazelnuts and liquorice, with herbs, cinnamon and vanilla as well.” –Winemaker notes. **New item.**

2014 Kevin White Winery Red Blend Yakima Valley \$21.99/\$16.99/\$15.29

Kevin White Microsoftee was named “Winemaker to Watch” by Seattle Magazine in 2015. Only 388 cases were produced of his 2014 Côtes-du-Rhône-style blend. “This wine jumps out as a lively blend of Bing cherry, plum and blueberry aromas with floral and spice elements throughout. On the palate, these flavors are wrapped around a medium body with soft tannins leading toward a lovely finish. A very enjoyable wine to drink now. 54% Syrah, 23% Grenache, 23% Mourvèdre.”

2013 San Felice Sangiovese Chianti Classico Tuscany \$21.99/\$14.99/\$13.49

“A sparkling ruby, this wine offers complex, long-lingering aromas, with nuances of dark cherry, raspberry and sweet violets. Appealingly dry and medium-bodied, it is smooth, rounded and well balanced. Overall, its judicious structure, elegant fragrances and savory palate make this a delectable experience.” –Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2013 Domaine Lafage ‘Bastide Miraflores’ Vieilles Vignes Côtes Catalanes \$16.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

“One of the greatest red wine values I have tasted in the last year or so. A blend of 70% Syrah and 30% Grenache. Offers a big, sweet bouquet of blueberries, blackberries, acacia flowers, pepper and spice. This full-bodied, opulent, majestic dry red unleashes tremendous ripeness, richness and intensity. You’ll have to taste it to believe it! It should drink well for 2-5 years.” –*Robert M. Parker, Jr.*, 93 points. **New item.**

2014 Columbia Crest H3 Cabernet Sauvignon Horse Heaven Hills \$24.99/\$13.39/\$12.05

“This bold Cabernet opens with flavors of black cherries and blackberries with a touch of currants and vanilla, complemented by earth and mineral notes. Deep berry flavors lead to a soft tannin cocoa finish. A blend of 84% Cabernet Sauvignon and 16 % Merlot.”

–Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2015 Montaribaldi Rouge Dolcetto d’Alba Vagnona Italy \$17.99/\$13.39/\$12.05

“The Dolcetto d’Alba DOC Vagnona is a young red wine, extremely fruity. Ruby red with light purple reflexes. The bouquet is vinous, full of fruity hints of cherries and raspberries. Good structure, moderate acidity and the typical almond ending. It may be matched with starters, pasta dishes and white meat.” –Winery notes. **New item.**

2012 Ontañón Crianza Rioja Spain \$16.99/\$12.19/\$10.97

“Subtle and elegant but also powerful and dense with a natural fruit and mineral extract that is just not the norm in this region. The wines from this mountainous part of Rioja are known to combine acidity and elegant fruity profiles with mineral and herbal notes. It displays notes of black fruit and spice with natural and delicate acidity.”

–Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2014 Domaine de Piaugier ‘Grange’ Côtes-du-Rhône \$12.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

Proprietor Jean-Marc Autran is the fourth generation in his family to grow grapes in the Rhône village of Sablet. The vine age ranges between 20 and 45 years. Red and black cherries and a kiss of oak dominate the nose. Palate highlighted by cherry and blackberry then hints of garrigue. Nice lifted elegant finish. A blend of Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre and Carignan. **Organic. New item.**

White Wines

2014 Château la Canorgue Blanc Côtes du Luberon \$21.99/\$18.69/\$16.82

This **organic** Provençal white is a blend of Grenache, Clairette, Roussanne and Marsanne, grown at an elevated altitude which imparts a notable freshness. Deceptively pale yet fruit laden white wine with crisp acidity and freshness. Appealing aromas and uplifting apricot and white peach flavors. It makes you think you are drinking a baby Châteauneuf du-Pape Blanc, for like one quarter the price! **New vintage.**



2014 Cescon Italo Storia e Vini Pinot Grigio Veneto Italy
\$16.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

“Intense, lingering fragrances nutmeg and vanilla, peach and ripe tomato and acacia blossom. Dry and crisp, ripe, aromatic fruit, with hints of orange zest, mirroring the nose. A wine of exceptionally full flavor, lengthy and elegant. Enjoy with shellfish and with seafood dishes.” –Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2014 Domaine R de La Grange Muscadet Gravier
\$16.99/\$13.09/\$11.78

From northern France on the Atlantic coast, Muscadet is the go-to wine for the French when it comes to shellfish and a clean glass of wine! Delicious, salty, fresh and citric, it is a great aperitif and a wonderful match for salmon, goat cheese and all Asian foods! **New item.**

2015 Zellina Pinot Grigio Friuli Italy \$13.99/\$10.29/\$9.26

The mild climate of this area, given the remarkable closeness to the sea, is linked to winds from the coastal areas which allow the proper amount of precipitation. On the nose the wine is fruity when young, becoming more intense with age. On the palate it is velvety, dry, soft and well balanced. Excellent as an aperitif, and an ideal accompaniment to rice or pasta dishes, fish or shellfish. **New vintage.**

Rosé Wines

2015 JCB Rosé No. 5 Côtes de Provence \$29.99/\$18.99/\$17.09

Brilliant, rose-petal pink in color with purple nuances. The nose is delicate with scents of red berries, citrus and spicy white blossoms. Soft and delectable on the palate with floral notes and flavors of white fruit. Boasts remarkable balance and a fresh finish. A blend of Cinsault, Grenache and Syrah. **New item.**

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2015 Mr. Pink Rosé of Sangiovese Underground Wine Project Columbia Valley \$14.99/\$11.19/\$10.07

The first release of this all-Sangiovese Rosé from the Underground Wine Project, the collaboration of Mark McNeilly of Mark Ryan and Trey Busch of Sleight of Hand! Bright strawberry and watermelon fruit with spicy notes and a refreshing acidity make this a perfect go-to rosé. **New item.**

2015 Villa Wolf Pinot Noir Rosé Pfalz Germany
\$13.99/\$10.29/\$9.26

“Is made with fruit from vineyards farmed expressly for the purpose of producing a rosé. Upon harvest the fruit is given a brief maceration to extract a lovely salmon color from the Pinot Noir grapes. The resulting wine is light and refreshing, with deliciously bright fruit flavors and a clean, zippy finish. It’s perfect for holiday meals, especially when ham is involved.” –Winemaker notes. **New item.**

2015 Ryan Patrick Rosé Columbia Valley \$12.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

“Hints of fresh pomegranate. A bright mid palate with traces of strawberry and rhubarb precedes a crisp finish. 80% Syrah, 11% Cinsault, 5% Counoise and 4% Grenache. 500 cases produced.”
