2016 Domaine de la Bastide Blanche Bandol Rosé Provence (\$20.59)

This is a complex, perfectly balanced wine with lovely aromas of red-currant, peach, blood orange, rose and spice. The palate is dense with creamy berry fruit, citrus and stone flavors, ripe and full with bright balancing acidity with terrific density and length. Delicious now, this will improve over the next few years.

2015 Servaj Dolcetto Langhe Marchesi Di Barolo (\$11.19)

“Servaj” is Piedmontese dialect, for both “wild” and “creative”, a name chosen for this new and young wine from Marchesi di Barolo. Violet notes and distinctive maraschino cherry aromas. This fresh, medium bodied wine with a velvety feel on the palate is excellent on its own due to the low acidity, relative to other red grapes from the region (Nebbiolo and Barbera).”

Red Wines

2014 Feather Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley \$75.99/\$60.69/\$54.62

“This deeply layered Cabernet offers bright aromas of dark berry fruits with hints of earth and graphite that gently accent flavors of French prune and sweet spice. A silky wine with rich texture and a viscous mouthfeel that extends from midpalate throughout its lengthy finish.”
–Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2015 Mark Ryan Wild Eyed Syrah Red Mountain \$48.99/\$44.99/\$40.49

“A fantastic bottling sourced from the Olsen and Ciel du Cheval vineyards. This excellent Syrah wine opens with aromatics of smoked brisket, black tar, black olive and citrus blossom. The texture is deep and lovely with ripe flavors of cedar, black cherry, Kalmata olive tapenade and boysenberry liquor with orange rind. This is dense, polished and delicious wine that will cellar beautifully for a decade or more. (Best 2017-2027.) –*The International Wine Report*, 92 points. **New vintage.**

2015 Walla Walla Vintners Cabernet Franc Columbia Valley \$40.99/\$34.59/\$31.13

“This is our 20th edition of Cabernet Franc. We think this is one of the best we have ever crafted. This gracious Franc is jam-packed with flavors of fresh picked strawberries, blackberry and dark cherry, followed by a mid-palate of an exotic blend of roasted Roma tomatoes, eggplant and cassis, and a gripping finish of caramelized sugar. The smooth finish has ample hang time in order to experience the gracefulness of this wine and the balanced acid and tannins will allow this wine to age.”
–Winemaker notes.

2014 Emilio Moro Finca Resalso Tempranillo Ribera del Duero Spain \$32.99/\$27.99/\$25.19

“Spicy dark berries on the nose, with a suave floral quality building in the glass. Round and seamless in texture, offering sweet black and blue fruit flavors and a touch of smokiness. Shows more red fruit character on the finish, with silky tannins coming in late to add grip. This fruit-driven Ribera is pretty delicious right now.”
–*Vinous / Antonio Galloni*, 90 points. **New vintage.**

2014 L’Ecole Syrah Columbia Valley \$32.99/\$23.39/\$21.05

“Precise and harmonious, with layered raspberry, stony mineral and pepper notes framed by refined tannins. Drink now through 2023.”
–*Wine Spectator*, 91 points

2014 Board Track Racer ‘The Shift’ Columbia Valley \$26.99/\$23.39/\$21.05

“Snappy and well-built, with lively violet and boysenberry aromas, focused by fresh pepper and licorice flavors that finish with a twist of tannins. Syrah and Mourvèdre. Drink now through 2020.”
–*Wine Spectator*, 90 points

2016 Belasco de Baquedano “Llama” Malbec Mendoza \$17.99/\$12.49/\$11.24

Floral aromas and flavors of geranium and lilac and boysenberry compote with a silky, bright, dry-yet-fruity medium body and a graceful, compelling, medium-long vanilla toffee, citrus sorbets, minerals, and tomato chutney finish with fine tannins and light oak. A nicely layered, juicy and floral Malbec that is sure to please. **New vintage.**

2015 Guerrieri-Rizzardi Valpolicella \$16.99/\$12.19/\$10.97

“Elegant inky fruit, loganberry, blueberry and plum with a touch of chocolate and smoke on the nose. Classy, suave and polished palate packed with confit cassis, black graphite and underpinned by finely grained tannins and a good acidity. Exquisite.”
–*Decanter*, 90 points. **New item.**

2014 Fattoria Basciano Chianti Rufina \$16.99/\$12.19/\$10.97

“Aromas of blackberry, blueberry and mineral follow through to a medium body, firm and chewy tannins and a long, flavorful finish. Beautiful now.” –*James Suckling*, 90 points. **New vintage.**

2015 Servaj Dolcetto Langhe Marchesi Di Barolo \$16.99/\$11.19/\$10.07

“Servaj” is Piedmontese dialect, for both “wild” and “creative”, a name chosen for this new and young wine from Marchesi di Barolo. Violet notes and distinctive maraschino cherry aromas. This fresh, medium bodied wine with a velvety feel on the palate is excellent on its own due to the low acidity, relative to other red grapes from the region (Nebbiolo and Barbera).” **New item.**

2015 Greenstone Point Pinot Noir South Island New Zealand \$16.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

The Greenstone Point Pinot Noir is produced exclusively from Waipara fruit and carries a depth of flavor not often found in its Marlborough counterparts. Earthy and spicy notes prevail, with rich fruit and elegant oak fleshing out the mid palate - an impressive Pinot that consistently over delivers at a great value price point. **New vintage.**

2016 Peirano Estate Vineyards Estate Petite Sirah \$13.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

Fruity aromas and flavors of berry pie, honey roasted nuts, and cedar with a satiny, bright, fruity medium-to-full body and a tingling, interesting, medium-long grilled sweet potato, vanilla toffee, and cedar mulch finish with firm, earthy tannins and moderate oak. A rich, chewy Petite Sirah with great fruit and structure for the long haul.
New vintage.

2015 Domaine de la Brunely Rouge Ventoux \$12.99/\$8.39/\$7.55

It’s back! This beautiful Rhône red blend of 40% Syrah, 40% Grenache and 20% Carignan sees no oak and just a few months of bottle age. It has a sexy nose of thick blackberries and blueberries. A ton of ripe fruit flavors are combined with chalky, earthy, peppery spice, and lightly smoked bacon notes. This is a ton of wine for the money folks. Killer buy! **New vintage.**



White Wines

2015 Abeja Chardonnay Washington \$44.99/\$38.69/\$34.82

"This wine brings crystal clear aromas of candy corn, summer squash, clarified butter, spice and whiffs of tropical fruit. The palate is elegant in style, showing nuance and detail to the straw flavors that lead to a warm finish." -Sean P. Sullivan, 90 points . **New vintage.**

2015 Ghost Block Sauvignon Blanc Yountville Napa Valley \$24.99/\$21.49/\$19.34

"This bright, tempting, and silky sur lie aged Sauvignon Blanc boasts aromatics of ripe stone fruits, mainly white peach and honeydew melon. The wine has lively acidity of white grapefruit and subtle hints of peach and clove, with a citrus core. This single vineyard Sauvignon Blanc exhibits classic Napa Valley flavors, with a complex long lasting, refreshing finish." -Winemaker notes. **New vintage**

2015 Steele Cuvée Chardonnay California \$25.99/\$19.59/\$17.63

"Our flagship white wine, California Cuvée Chardonnay, really shows off Jed Steele's wizardry in blending. As with all great wines, the process begins with the selection of the right vineyards. We have worked with most of the great Chardonnay vineyards in California and have chosen these six prestigious properties to obtain the grapes for this wine." -Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2015 Nefarious Cellars Defiance Vineyard Estate Viognier Lake Chelan \$21.99/\$18.99/\$17.09

"Bursting with aromatics of pear, papaya, nectarine and lime zest. It's summer in a glass and one of our perennial favorites. Styled to be a delicate wine, packed with apricot and grapefruit, a pretty side of floral notes, with just a hint of minerality." -Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2014 Domaine de Trotereau Sauvignon Blanc Quincy Loire Valley \$19.99/\$16.79/\$15.11

"The small, historic Quincy appellation is experiencing a revival! Once highly esteemed, its unparalleled Sauvignon Blancs are now returning to the spotlight after decades spent in the shadow of Sancerre, its northerly neighbor. You'll appreciate the distinctive flavor profile: born from warmer soils, it tastes of ripe, succulent citrus devoid of grassiness, while boasting the same flinty nerve as a good Sancerre." -Anthony Lynch. **New vintage.**

2016 Cave de Saumur 'Saumur Blanc' Les Pouches Loire Valley \$13.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

From the incredibly diverse Chenin Blanc grape comes this terrific Loire Valley white. Medium weight, with apple, chalk and floral aromas, there's a lovely, mature, creamy mouthfeel to this, with glazed pear flavors that glide through the lush, medium-weight finish. Ripe and showy, but still dry and racy in the end. Delicious. **New vintage.**

Rosé Wines

2016 Domaine de la Bastide Blanche Bandol Rosé Provence \$26.99/\$20.59/\$18.53

This is a complex, perfectly balanced wine with lovely aromas of red-currant, peach, blood orange, rose and spice. The palate is dense with creamy berry fruit, citrus and stone flavors, ripe and full with bright balancing acidity with terrific density and length. Delicious now, this will improve over the next few years. **New vintage.**

2016 Domaine Les Grands Bois Rosé Côtes Du Rhône Les Trois Soeurs \$15.99/\$11.19/\$10.07

A new look but the same lovely Rosé that we've loved for years. A beautiful pale pink color, the nose offers peach, red raspberry and floral notes. The superb finish is refreshing and balanced with ripe strawberry tinged fruit. Only estate grown fruit. Direct pressing for the Carignan, saignée for the Grenache. **New item.**

2016 Château Grande Cassagne Rosé Costières de Nîmes \$13.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

Made from three grapes, the wine exudes red fruits and a strawberry perfume. This Rose is a blend of 60% Grenache, 35% Syrah, and 5% Mourvedre and comes from tiny berries of forty-plus year old vines. Fermented a short time on its skins, it retains an electric pink color, soaring aromatics, and fully dry palate. **New vintage.**
