2016 Domaines Ott “Château de Selle” Rosé Côtes de Provence (\$51.99)

“Pale in color, this ripe wine is beautifully balanced. It does have rich fruit, raspberries and wild strawberries. It also has a fine texture with plenty of acidity as well as a touch of pepper.” - *Wine Enthusiast*, 92 points. **(bottles remain)**

2016 Jakue Rosé Getariako Txakolina Spain (\$18.69)

2016 Domaines Ott “Château de Selle” Rosé Côtes de Provence
\$61.99/\$51.99/\$46.79

2016 Talai Berri Finca Jakue Rosé Getariako Txakolina Spain
\$22.99/\$18.69/\$16.82

2016 Lobo Hills Cabernet Franc Rosé Yakima Valley

2016 AIX Rosé Coteaux d’Aix-en-Provence **\$17.99/\$13.99/\$12.59**

“The 2016 vintage is the result of great passion and dedication to produce the best possible rosé. The hypnotizing salmon pink color reveals the fruity freshness of top quality Provence rosé. Its generous taste, harmonious structure and long finish make it the perfect Rosé to drink with friends all day long! Blend of 60% Grenache, 20% Syrah and 20% Cinsault.” -Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2016 Domaine La Croix Belle Caringole Rosé Côtes de Thongue
\$12.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

Established in 1794 and managed by Françoise and Jacques Boyer, the estate is set in the foothills of the Montagne Noire on fantastic soils, mostly gravels. Pale pink. This lively, fruity Rosé is filled with ripe, juicy fruits, rose petals and pear drops. Slightly tart palate, ripe juicy acidity and a refreshing finish. 50% Syrah and 50% Grenache. **New vintage.**

2016 Ananto Bobal Rosé Spain **\$10.99/\$7.99/\$7.19**

This Rosé is made using the traditional saignée method after the must has macerated with the skins. A temperature-controlled fermentation is then done, bringing out the full potential of this grape variety. Fruity and intense on the nose with well-defined varietal aromas. Fresh on the palate with pleasant flavors. Very well-structured. 100% **Organic**. **New item.**

White Wines

2015 Domaines Ott Blanc de Blancs Clos Mireille Côtes de Provence **\$48.99/\$39.99/\$35.99**

The expressive and fruity nose reveals an aromatic palette of broom, dried almonds and yellow melon. The ample and beautifully round mouth is fresh and acidic with notes of peaches and white plums, lemon zest and lime blossom. A rich and delicious finish with a silky crisp texture. **New item.**

2015 La Crema Chardonnay Sonoma Coast
\$28.99/\$18.69/\$16.89

“Floral, lemon, green apple, subtle oak and spice aromas. Lemon drop, white stone fruit, yellow plum and honeydew melon flavors. Richly textured and concentrated, with balanced acidity that drives a lingering finish.” -Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2015 Monte Tondo Montero Soave Classico
\$18.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

“Fresh and refined, this lovely wine boasts enticing scents of white spring flower, orchard fruit and a whiff of roasted herb. The bright palate offers nectarine zest, Bartlett pear and lively acidity while a mineral note closes the finish.”

2016 Château Pajzos Dry Furmint White Hungary
\$15.99/\$12.19/\$10.97

“Who even knew Hungary made dry white wines? The country is best known for Tokaji, gorgeously honeyed, lavishly sweet wines. Hungary is making dry whites again, and some of the wines are stunningly distinctive and delicious. Beguiling aromas of exotic fruit, Asian spices and anise. A waxy quality. An attractive, almost savory mineral flavor.” -Eric Asimov, *The New York Times*. **New item.**

2016 Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough New Zealand
\$15.99/\$11.19/\$10.07

“The vineyard where Fernlands Sauvignon Blanc is grown is one of Marlborough’s best. The soil is an ancient riverbed comprised of three unique terraces of free draining silty loam topsoil. The 2016 Marlborough vintage will be remembered for its abundance of sunshine. Fernlands is produced in a “New Generation” winery in the heart of Marlborough. We use stainless steel tanks!”

2016 Domaine des Cassagnoles Blanc Vin de Pays des Côte de Gascogne \$12.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

A blend of 50% Colombard, 30% Ugni Blanc and 20% Gros Manseng, from Gascony southeast of Bordeaux, this wine is aromatic with plenty of fruit, floral notes and good acidity. A crisp and refreshing wine perfect for sipping or with seafood and salads. **New vintage.**

Prosecco Sparkling Wines

Case Bianche Prosecco Superiore Extra Dry Valdobbiadene NV \$21.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

Light yellow with fine persistent foam. Pleasant aroma, typically fruity with characteristic notes of Golden Delicious apples, peaches and acacia blossom. Slightly soft palate, harmonious and balanced by good acidity.

Ca' Furlan Extra Dry Prosecco Cuvée Beatrice NV \$15.99/\$12.29/\$11.06

"Balanced and lightly juicy, this creamy Prosecco offers textbook notes of white peach, almond skin and orchard blossom, as well as lemon zest and spice details on the finish. Drink now. Best Value." *-Wine Spectator*, 87 points

La Luca Prosecco Veneto NV \$16.99/\$11.34/\$10.25

The nose is instantly defined and distinctive, offering up bold orchard fruits, crisp pears and lemon curd, all of which come together in a rich, creamy off-dry style that is extremely appealing. There is a deft touch of minerality, playing nicely against the subtle sweetness of the wine. Vinified entirely in stainless steel. The finish shows excellent length and fine overall balance.

Soligo Brut Prosecco Veneto Italy NV \$16.99/\$10.99/\$9.89

This dry sparkling wine from Northeastern Italy is the ideal aperitif, and its crisp acidity allows pairing with a wide range of dishes. It displays bright, clean flavors of lemon, white peaches, minerals and bitter almonds.

Mille Prosecco Millesimato Brut Veneto NV \$14.99/\$9.99/\$8.99

This sparkling wine is a pale, golden straw in color. Bubbles are full textured and persistent. On the nose the wine brings fresh citrus with hints of honey and white flowers. The flavor is fresh and clean, with ripe citrus, lemon, green apple, with touches of grapefruit, minerality, and some toast. The finish is light, refreshing and crisp.

Montelliana Prosecco Treviso Extra Dry Italy NV \$13.99/\$8.79/\$7.91

This extra-dry sparkling wine from 100% Prosecco grapes produced by soft pressing and natural fermentation exhibits tight bubbles and good fruit flavors right up front. Complemented by intense fruity aromas of hazelnuts and pear, this sparkling wine is perfect to sip alone or with hors d'oeuvres and starters.

Vandori Prosecco Extra Dry Sparkling White Wine Italy NV \$10.99/\$7.99/\$7.19

One of the world's best under \$10 bottles of wine! Light and slightly fruity, this Italian sparkler makes an excellent starter wine. Gentle pear and melon flavors lead off before transitioning into a whisper of honey with a trace of minerality. Well balanced, pleasant and fresh flavors. Fine and persistent finish. 100% Macabeo.

Red Wines

2015 Isenhower Cellars Cabernet Franc Yakima Valley \$25.99/\$18.69/\$16.82

From Dutchman Vineyard, planted by Bill Den Hoed. Hand harvested and destemmed, this Loire-style Cabernet Franc is bright and fruity, with good acid and minerality. Tannins on the finish are soft and integrated. Try it with a chill at your next BBQ! **New item.**

2016 Saint Come Côtes du Rhône \$16.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

"After the magnificent 2015, here is the superb 2016. The region combines old vines, magnificent terroirs, fairly low yields and an outstanding climate. This 2016 vintage shows top quality fruit of blackcurrant and wild raspberry, magnificently intense color and layered texture with notes of truffle and licorice. Although this wine is designed for early-drinking, it can be kept for long."
