Red Wines

2014 DeLille Cellars D2 Proprietary Red Wine \$44.99/\$41.99/\$37.79

“It’s a soft, voluptuous, medium-bodied effort that offers loads of currants, black cherries, strawberries and leafy herb aromas and flavors. It’s already hard to resist, yet there’s quality tannin hiding under its fruit, and I suspect it will surprise you with its longevity.”
–*Wine Advocate*, 92 points. **New vintage.**

2014 Avennia Gravura Bordeaux Red Blend Columbia Valley \$35.99/\$32.69/\$29.42

“Another great year for this cuvee, the 2014 Gravura checks in as 51% Cabernet Sauvignon, 37% Merlot and the balance Cabernet Franc. It’s a plump, rounded, sexy red from Chris that has terrific notes of blackcurrants, leafy herbs and lead pencil. Medium to full-bodied, it shows the house style but in a more forward, early drinking, delicious style. Drink 2017 – 2026.”
–*Wine Advocate*, 92 points. **New vintage.**

2014 Brick House Gamay Noir Ribbon Ridge Willamette Valley \$35.99/\$29.89/\$26.90

“Brick House was one of the first to plant Gamay Noir in the Willamette Valley, and may well be the state’s leading producer in terms of quantity. This is loaded with chunky cherry fruit, a penetrating style that simply brings a grin with every sip. Aromatics of root beer, sassafras and hard cherry candy add to the complexity. Editors’ Choice. Biodynamic.”
–*Wine Enthusiast*, 91 points. **New vintage.**

2015 Board Track Racer ‘The Shift’ Columbia Valley \$26.99/\$23.39/\$21.05

“A classic partnership of Syrah and Mourvèdre, the 2015 Shift showcases bold aromas of blackberry, cocoa and blueberry. The palate is lush and juicy, offering more black and blue fruit and adding white pepper and roasted game. The small percentage of Mourvèdre has a buoyant effect on the aromatics, adding brightness and extra complexity to the blend. 88% Syrah and 12% Mourvèdre”

2016 Involuntary Commitment Red Columbia Valley \$19.99/\$17.99/\$16.19

Andrew Will’s new project! “A wine with the instinctive elegance of the involuntary and the comforting strength of commitment. This blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc and Merlot shows balance, full flavor and goes as well with a casual weekday dinner as it does with a highly anticipated special occasion. With such great fruit coming out of our vineyards this year, we just couldn’t help but spread the wealth.” –Winemaker notes. **New item.**

2015 Domaine de Châteaumar ‘Cuvee Bastien’ Côtes du Rhône \$18.99/\$15.99/\$14.50

The cuvée Bastien, named after the winemaker, Frederic’s son, is made from a single vineyard of 50+ year-old Grenache vines. Rich, fruity and elegant with a rip open knit, with lots of black cherry and spice, graphite and rich earth notes. The Souret Family has been running the vineyard for over three generations. Drink within the next six years. **New vintage.**

2015 Chateau Ste. Michelle Cabernet Sauvignon (50th Anniversary) \$21.99/\$14.39/\$12.95

“Cabernet Sauvignon is a standout variety from Washington, with silky tannins, rich complexity and concentrated fruit. That’s why our Columbia Valley Cabernet is the perfect choice to carry the nostalgic banner of our 50th anniversary. Raise a glass and help us celebrate the next 50 years!” –Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2015 Ross Andrew Glaze Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley \$23.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

“Best Buy! Ross Andrew Mickel made his name in the Woodinville wine scene, and now his wines are poured in downtown Walla Walla. This fresh product under his remarkable Glaze program is a remarkable value with some nice layers of complexity. Dark cherry, blackberry and vanilla aromas include light toast, baking spices and leather. Rating: Outstanding!”

2016 Belasco de Baquedano Llama Malbec Mendoza \$17.99/\$12.49/\$11.24

“Modern wine with attractive dark cherry-red color with violet hues. The nose shows great intensity. Fruit aromas of cherries, blackberries and plums stand out against a background of fine toast hints from ageing in top-quality oak. Warm, rounded and well-structured on the palate, with an explosion of fruit flavors underscored by light oaky notes. Pleasant, persistent aftertaste.”

2014 Fattoria di Basciano Chianti Rufina Tuscany \$16.69/\$12.19/\$10.97

“Aromas of blackberry, blueberry and mineral follow through to a medium body, firm and chewy tannins and a long, flavorful finish.”

2015 Rive Droite Rive Gauche Côtes du Rhône \$14.99/\$10.29/\$9.26

This is a full-bodied, spicy red wine that’s packed with black fruit aromas. The palate is full, silky and round with elegant structure to provide effortless enjoyment. It delivers loads of tasty fruit flavors with subtle savoury notes, finishing long and velvety. This is how a Côtes du Rhône should taste. 50% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 10% Mourvèdre, 5% Cinsault and 5% Carignan.
New item. Excellent wine for the money!



**2014 Hyatt Vineyards Estate Syrah Rattlesnake Hills
\$16.99/\$9.39/\$8.45**

This 2014 Syrah exhibits dark red color and distinctive Syrah aromas of spice and tropical fruit and balanced tannins. Not overblown or overly oaky. Sugar levels were not an issue and acids stayed in a good range. This is a great everyday Syrah. Estate-grown and bottled since 1983! **New vintage.**

**2016 Boekenhoutskloof 'The Wolftrap' Red South Africa
\$13.99/\$8.99/\$8.09**

The nose entices with its abundance of ripe plums, blueberries, slight spiciness and notes of violets. Dark berry fruit follows through onto a juicy, vibrant mid-palate. The wine shows exceptional balance with fresh, integrated acidity. Plummy fruit and spice lingers on the finish. A blend of 86% Syrah, 13% Mourvèdre and 1% Viognier. **New vintage.**

White Wines

2016 Lachini Pinot Gris Oregon \$23.99/\$19.99/\$17.99

"Aromas of flint, stone, honey and lemon cake leading to a strikingly intense palate accented by caramelized green apple notes. The expressive mid-palate enters with a core of crisp apples and rounds with a velvety mouthfeel of vivacious tropical flavors that intertwine perfectly with the lively acidity. The clean, dry finish concludes wine an uplifting texture that lingers and a definitive mineral lift on the finish." -Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

**2015 Foundry Vineyards White on White Walla Walla
\$18.99/\$15.89/\$14.30**

37% Chardonnay, 24% Marsanne, 21% Roussane and 18% Viognier. Leading with Chardonnay, this wine has bright, focused red apple and pear fruit. The Marsanne and Roussane add elements of spice, flowers along with luxurious texture. The Viognier brings a sense of volume to the palate which gives way to a smooth, viscous finish of tropical fruits, such as pineapple and guava. **New vintage.**

2016 Kim Crawford Sauvignon Blanc Marlborough New Zealand \$27.99/\$14.99/\$13.49

"Light straw with yellow and green hues. Aromas of citrus and tropical fruits backed by characteristic herbaceous notes for which Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is renowned. An exuberant wine brimming with juicy acidity and fruit sweetness, providing a balanced flavor profile. The finish is fresh, zesty and lingering." -Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2016 Protos Verdejo White Rueda Spain \$13.99/\$10.29/\$9.26

"Greenish straw color, bright and clean. Powerful on the nose, showing notes of green apple, citrus and tropical fruits, white blossoms, fragrant herbs and fennel. Very fresh on the palate, with good acidity. Flavorful, fruity, well balanced, complex, with a long finish and slightly bitter aftertaste."

2015 Cellaro Grillo Bacaro Terre Siciliane \$13.99/\$9.99/\$8.99

Rather bright yellow, golden shades. Fresh notes of citrus and lemon mint paired with yellow plums and mango, a trace lime blossom. On the palate of vibrant aromas, along with the yellow stone fruit and a juicy freshness touch, perfectly balanced; lively finish. **New vintage.**

Rosé Wines

2016 Conventino Rosato Toscana \$19.99/\$16.29/\$14.66

The product of a classic, ripe vintage in Toscana, this '16 Rosato wafts with Sangiovese's juicy cherries and berries, crushed wildflowers, fresh Tuscan earth, and kisses of baking spices, all conveyed in a sprightly, food-friendly palate. This wine is explosive yet dry, and quite a value. The Il Conventino winery was one of the first in the region to adopt the practice of organic farming.

2016 Michel Lynch Rosé Bordeaux \$13.99/\$10.99/\$9.89

"Michel Lynch Rosé is produced by the famous Lynch-Berge Estate. Supple, round and full-bodied, it delivers aromas of fruit drops, an aromatic range that is typical of the Bordeaux region and a particularly refreshing finish. A blend of 70% Cabernet Franc, 15% Cabernet Sauvignon and 15% Merlot."
