Two new, highly anticipated local favorites arrived this week. Let's feature them here:

2013 DeLille Cellars Doyenne Aix Columbia Valley (\$36.99)

"The Provençal-styled blend, the 2013 Doyenne Aix is the same blend as the '12 (60/40 Syrah Cabernet) and gives up lots of dark fruits, crushed herbs, lead pencil shaving and ground pepper characteristics in a concentrated, rich, medium to full-bodied package. There's lots to love here. Drink now through 2033."
-*Wine Advocate*, 90-92 points.

2015 Lobo Hills Sauvignon Blanc Lonesome Springs & Airport Ranch Vineyards Yakima Valley (\$15.89)

"Aromas of lemons, grapefruit, apple and kiwi. The full, rich mouthfeel has a surprising updraft of acid, which refreshes the palate, yielding gently to flavors of honeydew melon, stones and alfalfa. A quintessential food wine. Consume now or within 10 years. 438 cases made."
Winemaker notes.

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Red Wines

2012 Andrew Will Cellars Red Champoux Vineyard Yakima Valley \$81.99/\$69.99/\$62.99

"A blend of 64% Cabernet Franc, 22% Merlot and 14% Cabernet Sauvignon. Full-bodied, serious and loaded with tannin, it offers impressive currant and darker fruits, tobacco leaf and crushed rock-like aromas and flavors that continue to gain depth and richness with time in the glass. Drink 2020 through 2035." -*Wine Advocate*, 94+ points. **New vintage.**

2013 Evening Land Pinot Noir Seven Springs Vineyard Eola-Amity Hills \$64.99/\$55.99/\$50.39

"Crisp and tangy, with a mineral character running through the raspberry and cherry flavors at the core, coming together with harmony and structural tension on the vibrant finish. Best from 2017 through 2023." -*Wine Spectator*, 92 points. **New vintage.**

2012 Duckhorn Paraduxx Proprietary Red Blend Napa Valley \$57.99/\$39.99/\$35.99

60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 37% Zinfandel and 3% Petit Verdot. "A soft and fruity red with blackberry, blueberry character and hints of bitter orange. Full body, firm tannins and fresh finish. Outstanding." -*James Suckling*, 90 points. **New vintage**

2013 DeLille Cellars Doyenne Aix Columbia Valley \$39.99/\$36.99/\$33.29

"The Provençal-styled blend, the 2013 Doyenne Aix is the same blend as the '12 (60/40 Syrah Cabernet) and gives up lots of dark fruits, crushed herbs, lead pencil shaving and ground pepper characteristics in a concentrated, rich, medium to full-bodied package. 2012 Domaine Gachot-Monot Rouge Côte de Nuits-Villages \$34.99/\$29.89/\$26.90

Damien Gachot and his wife, Lise, are fifth-generation vignerons. Dive in and experience the most complete and balanced red Burgundy from this vintage! Bursting with style, class, depth and complexity for a price that can't be beat. Deep aromas and flavors of brambly black fruit with subtle notes of tobacco and earth. Well-balanced, with round tannins and refined tannins. 100% Pinot Noir. Kermit Lynch Import. **New vintage.**

2013 L'Ecole No 41 Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley \$35.99/\$27.99/\$25.19

"With its classic varietal Cabernet profile, this focused and integrated wine shows layers of dark fruit, coffee, sage and baking spice. Flavors of plum, blackberry and cassis vibrantly mingle with dusty fine tannins through a balanced, expressive finish." -Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2011 Descendientes de Jose Palacios Red Pétalos del Bierzo Spain \$26.99/\$20.59/\$18.53

"Always among the best values of Spain. It's aromatic, open and expressive, with floral aromas and bright fruit, wild strawberries and violets. This is always a subtle, medium-bodied wine, with fine tannins, sleek acidity and a fine minerality. Drink 2016-2020." -*Wine Advocate*, 92 points

2014 Mark Ryan BTR Cellars 'The Vincent' Red Columbia Valley \$21.99/\$18.99/\$16.82

"The 2014 Vincent Red offers clean, pure aromas of black cherry, black raspberry, cedar-lined spice and vanilla. The palate is bold, with mouth-filling blueberry and blackberry with more warm spice and subtle licorice flavor. The finish is remarkably balanced, focusing firm but round tannins and refined acidity." -Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2012 Jones of Washington Cabernet Sauvignon Estate Vineyards Wahluke Slope \$16.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

"Displays expressive aromas of dark cherry, pomegranate with nuances of mocha and rose petal. Rich and juicy on the palate, the wine's concentrated bright blackberry, blackcurrant and pomegranate flavors are supported by fine tannins and balanced acidity, leading to an elegant finish with flavors of toasted oak and mocha." -Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**



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2014 Domaine La Manarine Carignan Rouge Côtes du Rhône
\$16.99/\$13.09/\$11.78

Domaine La Manarine is a small, family-owned winery established in 2001. The vines average around 35 years in age. This wine is 100% Grenache and produces a classically spicy, full-bodied wine that speaks clearly of the “garrigue” of the region. The wine is bottled without filtration. Unoaked, with aromas of dark berries and ripe, rustic tannins.

2014 Verso Rosso Salento Molise Italia \$21.99/\$12.19/\$10.97

“Verso is a very full-bodied, luscious wine made with a small percent of raisined grapes. About 10,000 cases total are made, which is of course very small for Puglia. Rich and dark in color, with vibrant spice flavors, it is a hedonistic experience that captures the polished side of Negroamaro and Primitivo. A blend of 60% Negroamaro, 35% Primitivo and 5% Malvasia Nera.” -Small Vineyards. **New vintage.**

White Wines

2014 Napa Cellars Chardonnay Napa Valley \$27.99/\$18.09/\$16.28

“At Napa Cellars, we are putting a modern spin on classic Napa wines, combining Napa’s legendary terroir with contemporary sensibilities to create delicious wines that possess all of the character you’ve come to expect from Napa, but with an attitude and price that we think you will find rather refreshing.” -Winery notes. **New vintage.**

2015 Butter by Jam Cellars Chardonnay California
\$23.99/\$16.99/\$15.29

Made by winemaker Rob Lloyd of Rombauer fame. “Rich, bold and luscious, this is an easy-to-love creamy California Chardonnay. The fruit we choose has juicy, ripe, stone fruit and baked-lemon aromas. Cold fermented to the perfect, rich creaminess and aged in our own blend of oak, gives this wine a lovely, long, vanilla finish that’s uniquely Butter!”

2015 Lobo Hills Sauvignon Blanc Lonesome Springs Ranch & Airport Ranch Vineyards Yakima Valley \$18.99/\$15.89/\$14.30

“Aromas of lemons, grapefruit, apple and kiwi. The full, rich mouthfeel has a surprising updraft of acid, which refreshes the palate, yielding gently to flavors of honeydew melon, stones and alfalfa. A quintessential food wine. Consume now or within 10 years. 438 cases made.”
 Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2015 Talmard Blanc Mâcon-Chardonnay \$15.99/\$10.29/\$9.26

The Talmard family has grown grapes on the same land since the 17th Century. It is the prototype of a small Burgundy winery—a nugget. This wine comes from the village of Chardonnay and is pure express of Chardonnay in its simplest expression. The nose is floral and expressive with a subtle hint of peach. Fruity and round in the mouth, slightly mineral with notes of citrus. **New vintage.**

2015 Hayes Valley Chardonnay Monterey County
\$12.99/\$9.99/\$8.99

“Aromas of pineapple, apples and fresh baked bread. A hint of vanilla. A very light overall aroma of cedar. Flavors of pineapple, green apple and lemon/lime. A hint of toasty oak and a slightly creamy mouthfeel. Minimal tannins, medium-high acidity and very dry.”
 -Winery notes. **New item.**

2014 Marcato ‘La Giaretta’ Pinot Grigio Veneto Italy
\$13.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

Low yields and gentle pressing have ensured intensity and concentration in this ripe white from the Marcato family estate in the Colli Bercici. Lively and intense with complex stone fruit flavors and notes of almond, citrus and pear coming through in the impressive finish. **New vintage.**

Rosé Wines

2015 Hecht & Bannier Rosé Côtes de Provence
\$19.99/\$14.99/\$13.49

“For our Côtes de Provence we take a path quite apart from the one we follow for our Languedoc Rosé with its high proportion of Syrah. We have sought a Provence Rosé of immense charm and minerality redolent of dried herbs and mountain flowers. A blend of 45% Grenache, 40% Cinsault and 15% Syrah.” -Gregory Hecht. **New vintage.**

2015 Gérard Bertrand Rosé Côte des Roses Languedoc
\$18.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

“A soft, pale, brilliant pink with bluish tints developing over time towards more orangey nuances. The bouquet releases aromas of summer fruits, cassis and redcurrant. Floral notes of rose along with hints of grapefruit complete the picture. The finish is fresh, offering notes of candy. On the palate the impression is fresh and full, with great aromatic persistence and balance.” - Gérard Bertrand. **New item.**

2015 Mark Ryan BTR Cellars ‘The Vincent’ Rosé Columbia Valley
\$16.99/\$13.99/\$12.59

“The 2015 Rosé is produced in the traditional saignée style. The color is a very pale pink with a small hint of light orange. Fresh strawberries, lemon zest and white flowers come forward on the nose. This Rosé is delicate and light on the palate, yet incredibly vibrant with acidity.” – Winemaker notes. **New vintage. Last call. (Yes, already!)**

2015 Domaine les Grands Bois Rosé Les Trois Soeurs Côtes du Rhône \$16.99/\$12.19/\$10.97

“Beautiful presentation with a pale pink color with perfect brightness. The nose releases a fruity bouquet and late summer peach and raspberry all enhanced by a floral note. On the palate its generosity envelopes the palate with a silky mouthfeel with accents of crushed strawberries, grenadine syrup with a touch of licorice. The finish is balanced with ripe extremely pleasant fruit.” -Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**
