Looking for something new, unique and tasty beyond belief? Wanting to mix it up a bit? Here are three of our staff's absolute favorite, off the wall, insanely delicious white wines to satiate your palate!

2014 Lucien Crochet Sauvignon Blanc Sancerre (\$29.89)

A classic Crochet wine, intense, zesty, pure and linear, refreshing citrus rind character, limes lemons and minerals with a peachy ripeness, remarkably intense and concentrated for a regular Sancerre.

2015 Ermes Pavese Blanc de Morgex et de la Salle Italy (\$27.99)

Ermes Pavese is a young grower in the Alps, who works with a native grape known as Prié Blanc. A stunning wine from the highest vineyard site in Europe. The combination of high altitude and pre-phylloxera root stock makes for a wine that is racy and austere with intense minerality and lots of acidity. This is a truly distinctive, food-friendly wine.

2016 Savage Grace Grüner Veltliner Columbia Gorge (\$20.59)

12-14 year-old vines in planted on an extinct volcano. Soil here is a deep, well-drained, volcanic, sandy and clay loam. 80% neutral barrel and 20% stainless steel tank. This is a great food pairing wine, offering flavors of citrus fruit, honey and wet stone. Try it with shellfish and asparagus. 246 cases made

Red Wines

2010 Château Pédesclaux Rouge Pauillac Grand Cru Classé \$64.99/\$54.99/\$49.49

"Very pretty with currants, chocolate and hints of cappuccino. Full body, with velvety tannins and a long delicious finish. This is the best wine in years from here. Better in 2017."

-James Suckling, 93 points. **New item.**

2014 Mark Ryan 'Old Vines' Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley \$69.99/\$59.99/\$53.99

"A Classic, old school, Washington state Cabernet that gives up big, rich notes of dark fruits, chocolate, truffle and licorice. This full-bodied, concentrated 2014 has notable tannic grip, a big mid-palate and a great finish. It will evolve nicely for 4-5 years than drink nicely for more than 10-15 years." -*Wine Advocate*, 93-95+ points. **New vintage.**

2011 Villa St. Anna Rosso Di Montepulciano \$37.99/\$32.69/\$29.42

Red cherry berry fruit with nice concentration, a light herb and earth component, sage and old leather saddle, 90% Sangiovese 10% other. A lean style of Rosso with a light metallic nuance to the finish, a very rustic wine with red plum and cherry fruit and an earthy finish, herbs and sage. **New vintage.**

2014 Domaine de la Bastide Blanche Bandol Provence \$32.99/\$26.19/\$23.57

Burly, complex and soulful red. A muscular core of black currant and blackberry with earthy tones of dried herbs and meat. Worn leather and dried anise details line the finish, while the fruit smolders. Situated in St. Anne de Castellet, a terroir of Bandol rich in limestone. This and the high proportion of Mourvèdre give this domaine some of the most ripe and expressive of Bandol. **New vintage.**

2015 Delas Rouge Les Launes Crozes-Hermitage \$26.99/\$23.39/\$21.05

"I suspect the best vintage for this cuvée to date. Has terrific notes of plums, black raspberries, toasted spice and damp earth. Medium to full-bodied, polished and elegant, with sweet tannin, this terrific Syrah shows the richness and purity of the vintage. It continues to keep this large estate up with the crème de la crème of the Northern Rhône. Drink: 2016-2024."

-*Wine Advocate*, 90 points. **New vintage.**

2008 Bodegas LAN Tempranillo Gran Reserva Rioja Spain \$26.99/\$20.99/\$18.89

"Aromas of ripe red fruits combined with spicy notes from the aging in oak (Vanilla, cinnamon, fennel, liquorice root) and tertiary aromas (Leather, cigar box...) from its prolonged bottle ageing. Full bodied and round, its mouthfeel is elegant and very well balanced."

-Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2010 Bodegas LAN Reserva Tempranillo Rioja Spain \$21.99/\$16.79/\$15.11

Blackberry, pomegranate and orange peel flavors mingle in this lively red. Sweet-tart acidity imparts a slightly candied character, while chewy tannins keep this grounded. Drink now through 2018. **New vintage.**

2012 Hestia Cellars Red Columbia Valley \$19.99/\$15.99/\$14.39

"This locally produced blend has beautiful, lush aromas and flavors of plum, raspberry, chocolate and dark cherry with hints of vanilla and spice followed by a smooth and velvety finish. 50% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Cabernet Franc, 15% Merlot and 5% Petit Verdot."

2015 Columbia Crest Grand Estates Cabernet Sauvignon Columbia Valley \$16.99/\$9.99/\$8.99

"This bold style Cabernet Sauvignon displays great complexity and structure. There are aromas of dark berry fruits and plum on the nose with chocolate and vanilla on the palate. Blended with 75% Cabernet Sauvignon with smaller amounts of Merlot and Cabernet Franc."

2015 Shenandoah Vineyards Zinfandel Special Reserve
\$13.99/\$8.39/\$7.55

“From the amazing 2015 vintage comes this well-focused, medium-body Amador Zinfandel with the majority of the grapes coming from our exciting new, sustainably-farmed Jackson Valley estate. This zesty, richly fruited wine is bursting with lush flavors and aromas of black and red fruit that define its appeal. Smooth elegant and inviting, this easy drinking offering.” –Winery notes. **New vintage.**

White Wines

2014 Ladoucette Pouilly-Fume Sauvignon Blanc Loire Valley
\$45.99/\$32.69/\$29.42

“The nose develops a natural range of subtle floral and earthy green plant aromas such as, cacia, ferns, peppermint and white nettles. Notes of stony minerals and lemon give the wine a beautiful structure balanced by a fruity roundness, with a finish marked by hints of citrus fruits.” –Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2016 Savage Grace Wines Grüner Veltliner Underwood Mountain Vineyard Columbia Gorge **\$23.99/\$20.59/\$18.53**

12–14 year-old vines in planted on an extinct volcano. Soil here is a deep, well-drained, volcanic, sandy and clay loam. 80% neutral barrel and 20% stainless steel tank. This is a great food pairing wine, offering flavors of citrus fruit, honey and wet stone. Try it with shellfish and asparagus. 246 cases made. **New vintage.**

2015 Joseph Drouhin Chardonnay Mâcon Villages
\$18.99/\$13.09/\$11.78

“The color of the wine is bright and limpid. The nose is floral and fruity. Very straightforward and direct on the palate, as if biting into a grape. Fresh and light, with a very pleasant aftertaste.” –Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2015 Hestia Dry-Style Riesling Columbia Valley
\$14.99/\$11.99/\$10.79

“A beautiful dry-style Riesling with notes of peach, pear, apricot and lemon. Great food pairing wine! Only 150 cases made.” –Winemaker notes. **New item.**

2015 Gran Passione Gavi White Piedmont **\$14.99/\$11.19/\$10.07**

“Delicate aromas of white flowers, lemon, and green apples. A crisp, medium-bodied palate showing underlying hints of chalky minerality. Well-balanced and distinctly fruit driven with underlying hints of almonds on the finish. Made from 100% Cortese.” –Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2015 Riff Pinot Grigio Trentino-Alto Adige Italy
\$13.99/\$9.39/\$8.45

“Fruity (apples, peaches), with elegant mineral notes. Quite pronounced, clean. Dry. Medium-bodied on the palate, crisp, well balanced and good length.” –Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

Rosé Wines

2016 Château Peyrassol Rosé Côtes de Provence
\$37.99/\$32.69/\$29.42

This is the elite cuvée of the estate. A blend of 47% Cinsault, 15% Tibouren, 12% Syrah, 8% Rolle, 6% Mourvèdre, 6% Grenache, and 6% Semillon. . The fruit flavors lean more floral and peach, with a touch of pear skin. This Rosé shows comparatively more richness and concentration, but also has a greater mineral depth that gives it a graceful quality. **New item.**

2016 Château de Campuget Rosé Tradition Costières-de-Nîmes
\$13.99/\$10.29/\$9.80

“This wine is an intense peony pink color. Its bouquet is very aromatic, exhaling scents of small red fruits such as raspberries or black currants. In the mouth, there is a perfect balance between vivacity and mellowness. The final taste is very long, leaving a delicate impression of fruitiness.” –Winemaker notes. **New vintage.**

2016 Ryan Patrick Rosé Columbia Valley **\$11.99/\$9.39/\$8.45**

A Rhône-style dry Rosé, offering aromas of pomegranate, lifting with an effervescence of strawberry and rhubarb precede with a crisp finish. A blend of 74% Syrah, 12% Cinsault, 8% Grenache and 6% Mourvèdre. **Double Gold Medal Winner at the 2017 Savor NW Wine Awards.**
New vintage.

2016 Mont Gravet Rosé Cinsault Pays d’Oc **\$9.99/\$7.49/\$6.74**

Mont Gravet Rosé is a wonderfully fresh and fruit forward dry Rosé wine. The wine has lovely aromas of raspberry and blackberry and is full bodied and long on the palate. **New vintage.**
